## York Branch - What we did in 2020

For 2020, NAFR activities have been much restricted, at least as regards the general membership. Our Ottawa staff, the national Board, and most Branch Boards have been busy working remotely and effectively. As for NAFR York, the Board met regularly by Zoom, and we held our general meetings the same way including the 2020 Annual General Meeting. Frank Froude has taken on the Web Editor role, and we now have a Branch website in the NAFR family. Sharon Carson has assumed the role of Advocacy lead (Project 338) and has started establishing contact with local MPs. Tom Nichols has taken on the Treasurer role, and all Board members are helping to cover off all his previous activities as Branch President. Sadly, the social aspect has been largely lost - meeting by Zoom is just not the same. And communications with our members who do not have e-mail or high-speed internet has been almost lost. All we have to reach such members are the twice-yearly newsletters in SAGE.

We are looking forward to a gradual resumption of "normal" operations, but most likely not until the fall.

## Branch AGM 2021

Our AGM in April will have to be online. Our own thinking has been pre-empted by the decision of the National Board. The June Annual Meeting of Members (NAFR's AGM) will also be online. Our AGM guest speaker will be Andrew Hau of Collette (NAFR preferred Travel Partner) – we're thinking that members will be ready to think about travel as the lockdown nears the end. A preliminary version of the Branch financial information for the AGM has been included on the next pages. As can be seen, restricted activities has resulted in a healthy surplus. A 2020 surplus is an issue at all levels of NAFR – one response is that the planned 2021 dues increase (to allow for inflation) was cancelled.

If our AGM were in person, we would display our Branch Commemorative Trophy, which serves to recognize meritorious service to the Branch – so a picture of the trophy is included above.

## Activity Plans for 2021

These Plans are still in development – it's hard to know how the year will unfold – though surely it will be better than 2020! Ideally, our Fall Members meeting should be a celebration of a "return to normal".

We also need to recognize that a federal election is likely and after all the COVID spending our pensions may be a target again.
