October 15th—Local Government Elections—Is that a ballot or a phone book?

If the number of candidates is a sign of health, our democracy at the local government level is robust. In White Rock, there are four candidates for mayor, and 16 vying for six councillor positions. In Surrey, there are eight mayoral candidates and 56 (!!!) nominees hoping to fill six council seats. Langley Township there are four candidates for mayor (Jack Froese is not running again), and 28 running for the eight other spots at the council table. In Langley City, there are two candidates for the mayor's job and 14 for the six council seats. These people make decisions that directly affect you and your neighbourhood. Take the time to get out and meet them. Make them aware of your concerns and your ideas for how we can make our communities better for everyone.

Celebrating Labour Day in the sun...

September 5th— The sun was out and so were a lot of happy people. In Surrey's Holland Park, there were speeches and music (the band was 'Common Ground'), cotton candy and face painting. The line-up of children for the balloon artist was especially long—not passport office long, but long. Speakers included Harry Bains, BC Minister of Labour, and Peter Julian, MP for New Westminster-Burnaby. Federal Retirees volunteers—from both Vancouver and Fraser Valley West branches—were there, waving our banner and recycling our 'four priorities' buttons from the 2019 and 2021 elections. At Mill Lake in Abbotsford, the Labour Day event was more informal; there were a variety of politicians but mainly for the municipal elections and no speeches. 
