# Guest speaker! Rowena Rizzotti **Legion Veterans Village**

At this year's Christmas meeting, we are honoured to have a special guest.

Rowena Rizzotti's 35 years of health-care leadership include serving as COO of B.C.'s Northern Health Authority, co-founding Surrey's Health and Technology District and co-founding the first Legion Veterans Village in B.C. Ms. Rizzotti sits on the Conference Board of Canada's Council for Innovation and Commercialization and was Surrey's Business Woman of the Year in 2018.

The Legion Veterans Village (LVV) project is Canada's first-of-its-kind, integrated centre of excellence for veterans & first responders focusing on post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and mental health as well as mixed medical and rehabilitative services. Led by the BC/Yukon Command of the Royal Canadian Legion, together with Whalley Legion Branch 229 and Lark Group in Surrey B.C., this unique \$312- million, two-phase, multi-purpose project is envisioned to be the first of
