MEMBERSHIP REPORT

Here we are in March 2023. The worst of the Covid-19 pandemic is our rear view mirror. Let's try and keep it that way by still practicing good health measures like keeping a safe distance and masking up in close proximity situations as well as vaccination shots!

Our Branch membership is still around 500 members. Once again, I ask that if you know of any Federal retiree or potential retiree please let them know about our Association or have them contact any member of the Branch executive for further information. Membership renewal for DDS (Direct Deduction from Source) has been raised to a monthly payment of \$4.38 for Single and \$5.69 for double. For those that pay annually it will be \$52.56 for singles, and \$68.28 for double memberships. This represents approximately 2.5% increase after holding the renewal fee the same for the last three years.

GOOD NEWS for 2023.

- 1. Pension index rate for 2023, is 6.3%
- 2. The Public Service Health Care Plan renewal with Canada Life also comes into effect on July 1, 2023 with increased benefits.
