At our Fall General Meeting we were asked by our members who have Belairdirect (MEDOC) travel insurance about replacement Belairdirect cards. We have investigated this issue and received the following update.

- Your Belairdirect (MEDOC) cards are sent out along with your annual Belairdirect (MEDOC) renewal information. Once you receive the card, you will need to write your policy number on it. Your policy number remains unchanged from your previous MEDOC number.
- For members who opted to receive their renewal electronically, Belairdirect sent an email titled "IMPORTANT information about your Belairdirect travel insurance policy." Inside this email, you will find a link labeled "Travel Insurance Card." Clicking this link opens a PDF document displaying a generic Belairdirect travel insurance card. You may print this card and manually write your policy number on it. Please remember that your policy number is the same as the MEDOC number you have used previously.
- If you do not have access to a printer, you can contact Belairdirect at 1-866-606-3362 to mail you a travel insurance card. Once you receive the card, ensure you write your policy number on it. Your policy number remains unchanged from your previous MEDOC number.

Another concern that has been raised is regarding payment of eyeglasses under our Public Service Health Care Plan (PSHCP). For those who are age 65 or over, and are residents of the Province of Manitoba, members have been required to submit claims to MB Health first and then to the PSHPC. Without this, the claim is denied based on the lack of submitted documentation about a Province of Manitoba [medical device subsidy program](#). The concern is that the service standards for the processing of claims is 8 weeks, however 3-to-6-month delays are not unusual imposing a burden on our members during the delayed period prior to payment of the claim by the PSHCP. A request has been submitted to our National Office to examine the situation for a resolution.
