8. Enhancement of a provincial tax credit for seniors

Quebec Finance Minister Éric Girard announced during his recent economic update, an increase in the refundable tax credit for support to seniors as of the next income tax return. This measure will greatly help eligible seniors, who are being hit hard by the rising cost of living.

By respecting its commitment to increase this tax measure this year, which increases the maximum amount from \$411 to \$2,000, the Government of Quebec will allow seniors who feel the most affected by inflation to breathe a little easier in a difficult economic climate.
