A Park for Everyone ? Make your Position Known !

Did you know that the National Capital Commission (NCC) has implemented a policy that restricts vehicle access in certain areas, notably Gatineau Park, since 2020? This policy aims to promote active mobility and reduce the environmental impacts linked to automobile traffic, especially during the Summer season which ends on September 22.



More specifically, the NCC closes the Gatineau Park parkway to cars all day on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. They are open to cars on Wednesday from 8 a.m. to 30 minutes after sunset, and on Saturday and Sunday from noon to 30 minutes after sunset. The shuttle was in service from May 20

to August 27, Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Accessibility by private vehicle is replaced by a shuttle system. It is important to find a balance between environmental objectives and the needs of the population.

This policy has raised concerns among seniors and retirees in the Outaouais, who feel that the restrictions limit their access to green spaces. L'Association québécoise de défense des droits des personnes retraités et préretraités de l'Outaouais (AQDR) has expressed its dissatisfaction with the situation and is calling for fair access for all. For its part, the CCN seeks to promote active mobility. In this context, NAFR Outaouais, in collaboration with la Table de concertation des aînés et retraités de l'Outaouais (TCARO), wishes to know the opinion of their members and the general population on the current policy of the NCC. Is this an issue that concerns you ?

By responding to this survey, you will help us determine whether the new NCC policy regarding accessibility to Gatineau Park is an issue. If the result shows that this is an issue for seniors, NAFR Outaouais in collaboration with various associations bringing together seniors will be able to take action. This survey takes less than 3 minutes to complete and the results will allow us to better represent you.
