


Meet and Chat April 17th

2024 BC election - October 19, 2024

Plans are in the works to collaborate in election town halls in Langley City and Township, and South Surrey/White Rock. We will also be canvassing candidates for all parties in the 14 ridings that fall within Fraser Valley West branch boundaries. Redistribution has given us two new ridings—Langley-Walnut Grove and Surrey-Serpentine River—and changed the names and rejigged the borders of several others. So it will be interesting to see where incumbents choose to run.
